Health and Safety Policy

General Statement of policy.

This document is the Health and Safety Policy of North Cadbury Village Hall and Recreation Ground.

Our Policy is to:

- a) Provide healthy and safe working conditions, equipment and systems for our volunteers, committee members and hirers.
- b) To keep the village hall and equipment in a safe condition for all users.
- c) Provide information as is necessary to volunteers, committee members and users.

It is the intention of North Cadbury Village Hall Management Committee to comply with all health and safety legislation and to act positively where it can reasonably do so to prevent injury, illness or any danger arising from its activities and operations.

North Cadbury Village Hall Management Committee considers the promotion of the health and safety of its volunteers at work and those who use its premises, including contractors who may work there, to be of great importance. The Management Committee recognises that the effective prevention of accidents depends as much on a committed attitude of mind to safety as on the operation and maintenance of equipment and safe systems. To this end, it will seek to encourage committee members and users to engage in the establishment and observance of safe working practices.

Volunteers, hirers and visitors will be expected to recognise that there is a duty on them to comply with the practices set out by the committee, with all safety requirements set out in the hiring agreement and with safety notices on the premises and accept responsibility to do everything they can to prevent injury to themselves or others.

The Safety and Wellbeing of all volunteers (Trustees), hall users, contractors and visitors at North Cadbury Village Hall is of paramount importance. Our COVID-19 rules are aimed to meet the Committees expectations with regards to the safe use of our hall during the pandemic to protect our community.
